The following is the report for fiscal year 2018-2019.

The department finished the year with 304 alarms compared to 295 alarms last year. We received 6 mutual aid assists and gave 20 assists to neighboring departments. Medicals continue to be the majority of our runs at 151 with PI's at 42 runs. Structure fire calls were at 13 as were wild fires.

Our response time from when we are dispatched to when the first unit arrives on scene was 10 minutes.

We continue to train 2 times a month covering a number of disciplines, and we are currently at 29 members. We recognized Mark Rotman for 20 years of service and Kirk Kraai for 30 years of service.

A truck committee was formed this past fall to work on a replacement for our 1996 International Rescue unit. We feel extremely fortunate that the funds are in place for this vehicle. The schedule for replacement is every 20 years so the new replacement will have to meet our needs for the future.

We were able to join the majority of Ottawa County Fire Departments in purchasing new reporting software. This is used for the State required reports for fires and medicals. By doing this together the county departments were able to save thousands of dollars. We were fortunate to be able to tap some computer savvy people from different Ottawa County departments to design it to our needs. This program went active January 1.

The county 800 megahertz system has not gone live as of yet, while they are addressing reception needs in parts of the County. The reception has tested good in our township.

February 27, retired Fire Chief, Russ Hirdes passed away after dealing with some health issues. Russ served Olive Township on the fire department for 39 years and was Chief for 29, he will be missed. The cover picture was taken at his funeral.

I want to thank the residents of Olive Township for their support in millage for the department. I also would like to thank the Fire Board and the Township Board for their continued support they give to make this a successful and well trained Department.
